## **Safety Precautions**

- Proper safety precautions shall be adhered to during removal work. Proper safety barricades shall be erected on site in order to protect pedestrians and vehicles from injury or damage. All sidewalks and roadways shall be kept free of debris.
- 2. Proper warning signs and warning lights shall be erected when directed by the Code Enforcement Officer.
- 3. All ladders, scaffolding and planking shall be erected in a safe and secure maner and shall be of proper weight and material to withstand the loads to which they will be subjected.

- 4. When electrical equipment is in use, such equipment shall be provided with ground fault interrupting devices. All temporary wiring shall be in accordance with National Electric Code.
- 5. It shall be the contractors responsibility to notify all Public and/or Private utility companies in advance of start of any work in order to Avoid damage or disruption of existing gas, electric, water, sewer, cable or phone lines in the work area.
- 6. It shall be the contractors responsibility to turn off the existing water service to the building as directed by the Code Enforcement Officer.

  The contractor shall also cut and properly cap existing sewer line service to the building.
