Application for Building Demolition & Removal Permit

Certificate of Insurance

Prior to the issuance of a demolition permit, a certificate of insurance for liability shall be given to the Code Enforcement Officer of the Town of Athens. The certificate of insurance shall name the Town of Athens as an additional insured. The limits of said liability shall be in the amounts as follows:

- 1. Three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000)
- 2. Five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000)
- 3. Fifty thousand dollars (\$ 50,000) because of damage to or destruction of property caused by any one (1) accident resulting from said demolition.

Fees

- 1. Fifty dollars (\$ 75.00) Residential
- 2. Seventy five dollars (\$ 100.00) Commercial plus any cost for any Special Permits Hazardous materials or Asbestos.

Application is hereby made to the Code Enforcement Office for the issuance of a Building Demolition and Removal Permit for Structure Removal as herein described. The applicant agrees to comply with All Laws, Ordinance and Regulations.

D. Hazardous materials or Asbestos removal is required, SPECIAL PERMIT will be necessary for their removal in addition to this permit.

Note: If debris is to be deposited at a landfill or transfer station, the contractor shall optain proper permits as required. Trucks used to cart debris shall be equipped with coving and/or tarpaulins in order to prevent debris from falling from trucks to roadway during transit.

Safety Precautions

- 1. Proper safety precautions shall be adhered to during removal work. Proper safety barricades shall be erected on site in order to protect pedestrians and vehicles from injury or damage. All sidewalks and roadways shall be kept free of debris.
- 2. Proper warning signs and warning lights shall be erected when directed by the Code Enforcement Officer.
- 3. All ladders, scaffolding and planking shall be erected in a safe and secure maner and shall be of proper weight and material to withstand the loads to which they will be subjected.

- 4. When electrical equipment is in use, such equipment shall be provided with ground fault interrupting devices. All temporary wiring shall be in accordance with National Electric Code.
- 5. It shall be the contractors responsibility to notify all Public and/or Private utility companies in advance of start of any work in order to avoid damage or disruption of existing gas, electric, water, sewer, cable or phone lines in the work area.
- 6. It shall be the contractors responsibility to turn off the existing water service to the building as directed by the Code Enforcement Officer. The contractor shall also cut and properly cap existing sewer line service to the building.
