5: Anyone wishing to be placed on the agenda to address the Town Board on a particular issue shall contact the Town Clerk at least two (2) business days prior to the meeting, giving their name, address & the topic wished to be discussed. Citizens are encouraged to limit their presentation to seven (7) minutes & to present to the Town Board supporting documentation as deemed appropriate to their position. Not allowing a petitioning citizen to address the Town Board is recognized as a serious matter, and if deemed appropriate, shall only be agreed to by a majority vote of the Town Board.

6: Any person addressing the Town Board shall direct his/her comment to the Supervisor & Town Board & not engage any Town Board Member, Department Head, or any other member of the audience in a debate.

7: A time will be allotted at each meeting for the assembled public to comment upon or to ask further questions of the Supervisor regarding any of the discussions which had taken place at this meeting. A 15-minute limit per topic from the floor.

8: At no time may any of this provision, as adopted, be modified without a majority vote of the Town Board.
